ASKY strengthens its network

Launched in mid-January in Lome, the airline is expanding its network. It introduced in early March 2010 four new destinations: Niamey, Douala, Conakry and Freetown. These stops come in addition to those already served: Ouagadougou, Accra, Bamako, Banjul, Brazzaville, Cotonou, Kinshasa, Libreville, Lome.

ASKY aims at becoming the first regional airline in West and Central Africa. The company currently has a fleet of two new Boeing 737-700 New Generation and a third aircraft is expected very soon. An ultra modern fleet which is the pride of Africa.

The schedules of some flights have been arranged to enable passengers departing from Lome take advantage of swift connections to Addis Ababa and fly on the international network of Ethiopian Airlines.

Lome is already imposing itself as a regional hub, which will be reinforced in the coming months with the extension of the networks of ASKY Airlines and Ethiopian Airlines.
